With Chanukah winding down, can Purim be far behind?

Although it comes late in the calendar (March 14) this year, it is time to gear up for a wonderful celebration of the festival that is not only full of fun but reminds us of our ability to overcome evil forces that seek to undermine or destroy us as a people.

I invite all would be lyricists and singers (or singer wannabes) to a meeting with me at 6 PM on January 8 to begin to prepare. We will take a good look at the story of Esther and assign character parts to those interested. Then I will invite you to pick a song from your favorite type of music and write Purim lyrics to it. Then as part of our gala Purim celebration on Shabbat Eve March 14, you will sing your song as part of the Purim story.

We will have a lot of fun, we will learn together, and then we will share both the fun and the learning with the congregation on March 14.

While Purim is most definitely a time for frivolity, the festival also has serious lessons to teach us about courage in the face of pressure, prejudice, and our destiny as Jews. We will explore those together.

If you are not a singer, and you wish to write a brief reflection on one of the characters in the story, that would be great too. And of course, if you only want to learn more about the message and meaning of the Story of Purim, but not perform, I eagerly invite you to join us as well.

Our Purim celebration will also include a massive Purim Pucker Ball and Hamantaschen Quiz. So, start studying the Book of Esther now to prepare to answer one of the many quiz questions I shall ask.

Needless to say, if you join us on January 8, you will have a huge heads up on some of the questions you will hear on March 14.

My wish for all of you this year is not to get bogged down in all the mishegas of the world and to focus on the good, spend time with people that you like spending time with and enjoy life.

Life is the greatest gift that G-d could ever give. If we spend our time living up to that gift, then we can't go wrong.

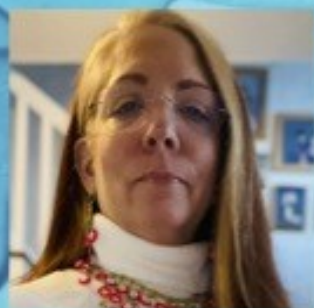



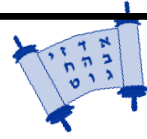
